Voter's Meeting Minutes - November 14, 2021

Meeting Started at 12:30pm, Christine called the meeting to order.

Due to Covid19 there were some physically present and others attending via Zoom meeting.

Proxies were read by Christine. Gary Stuhlmiller motioned to approve the proxies. Tom McGill seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Christine presented the new voters: Karen Kreymborg, Arthur Kreymborg, Carolyn McElfatrick and Robert McElfatrick. Donna Gesell motioned to approve the new voters. Beverly Hudgins seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Barb Tippin motioned to approve the minutes of the last voter's meeting as presented. Dave Johnson seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Votes were counted to verify there was a quorum.

Pastor's comments: Pastor stated this is our ministry. The world needs our ministry.

Pastor Brooks motioned to approve the statistical report as presented. Scott Gesell seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Ministry reports were presented. It was noted that Zoom Sunday School will continue through Easter 2022. Discipleship attachment wasn't included in the packet. Please see Bev if you would like a copy. Gary Stuhlmiller motioned to approve the ministry reports. Tom McGill seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Gary Stuhlmiller made a motion to approve the Funding report as presented. Beverly Hudgins seconded the motion. There was discussion regarding the special funds that were not included. Donna Gesell shared the background on the special funds for new members.

- Saints of Grace is money given in Memory of someone. The money is not spent unless voted on and is used for special projects. The balance in this fund is \$46,997.
- Shepherd's Tent is used as a building expense fund. The balance in this fund is \$22,412.
- Mitchell Endowment is interest received from an endowment created by two professors that were members of the church. The money is used only for outreach. Approximately \$6000 is received quarterly and the balance in this fund is \$64,735.

Additionally, it was noted that there is \$16,000 added at the end of the budget for the preschool. This is an estimate of cost to maintain the preschool through the end of May 2022. The question has been raised if money can be given to help defer the cost and the answer is yes.

All were in favor of approving the 2022 funding plan.

A motion was made by Dave Johnson to approve Pastor Brooks as the pastoral delegate, Beverly Hudgins as the Lay delegate and Christine Wethman as the alternate Lay delegate for the district convention. Scott Gesell seconded the motion. All were in favor.

Scott Gesell motioned to adjourn the meeting. Gary Stuhlmiller seconded the motion. All were in favor.

From Lay Minister of Education, Bev Hudgins May 2022

During the Sunday School hour these classes have been presented:

Zoom children's Sunday School has continued. Will break during summer. Parents are being surveyed to determine if this will resume in the fall.

During the last 6 months, the Deacons/Mutual Care have been working on the following:

- Deacons have continued to meet monthly, typically the third or fourth Monday of the month at 6 PM.
- Deacons are studying the book Real Faith for Real Life by Michael Foss. This book focuses on living the six marks
 of discipleship. Joyce Rea leads our book study.
- Deacons sent personal notes in cards and gift cards to 12 college and military members and friends of Grace in April. Included in each card was a \$10 Starbucks gift card. We are hopeful that ultimately, we can return to sending care packages with homemade goodies again.

- Deacons continue to lift up members, visitors, inactive members and friends of Grace in prayer. We pray for those people both privately and together when we meet.
- Mutual Care/Compassion Ministry mailed Easter cards with an Easter bookmark to our shut-ins.
- Mutual Care/Compassion Ministry plans to have a gift for our teachers on the Miss Mollie's recognition Sunday,
 May 22.

Mutual Care Ministry also encompasses the following and work in these ministries is ongoing:

- <u>Bereavement Ministry</u> Specializes in supporting congregation members who have experienced the death of loved ones by offering comfort to those who mourn with Stephen Ministry books. Grace continues supporting Growing Thru Grief throughout the year. Joyce Rea is the Deacon who serves in this special ministry.
- Stephen Ministry Provides support for congregation members who are struggling with life's difficult problems. There are currently 5 active Stephen Ministers at Grace. Stephen Ministers typically meets each week with their care receivers for an hour or more as needed. If you feel the calling to become a Stephen Minister, please reach out to Joyce Rea, Pastor Brooks, or Joe Wethman.
- Prayer Shawl Ministry ongoing creation of wonderful prayer shawls to share care, comfort, and the love of our Savior to those who are suffering in various ways. Anyone who can knit, or crochet can be an important part of this ministry.
- Compassion Ministry Provides cards to our home-bound members at Easter and Christmas. Also provides a
 card and small gift to college members and Military members two times a year. In the event that meals are
 needed we help to coordinate those needs.

No updates since last Voters Meeting, November 2021

From Grace House Administrators, Dede Crosmer & Donna Gesell May 2022.

Upstairs of Grace House continues to be used in cooperation with Host Homes program of Duke University Medical Center for family members of patients receiving treatment at Duke who are from outside the Durham area.

Since the last voters meeting, we have had two families.

Areas of concern:

- 1. sewage back-up, which is in the process of being evaluated
- 2. current condition of the house in general considering either having a contractor or home inspector look at the house
- 3. ceiling in downstairs laundry room still needs to be repaired
- 4. unidentified electrical problem in the kitchen
- 5. water leak in the upstairs ceiling
- 6. downstairs furnace needs to be replaced

From Lay Minister of Property & Facilities, Mike Hunike May 2022

During the last 6 months, the Properties and Facilities have been working on the following:

- 1. The stucco repair and painting is done for the sanctuary.
- 2. The electrical has been fixed for the memorial garden pole light and the outlet has been moved up for easier access with a switch to cut power if needed. Thanks Joe Milko.
- 3. Choir loft lights (2) not working it's not a bulb electrical problem.
- 4. Have to fix laundry room in Grace house from plumbing repair
- 5. Looking to get wood to lay down to vacuum air duct top in sanctuary to get webs removed.
- 6. Still working on painting railing around the church.
- 7. Filter order staying with replacing them every three months.
